Updates of Technical Circular (Works) No. 2/2021

With reference to the updates of Technical Circular (Works) No. 2/2021, the new tier of CIC-Certified BIM Coordinator (Associate), CCBC(A), can fulfil the BIM Coordinator requirement in the BIM team. For details, please see the paragraphs below extracted from the memo issued by Development Bureau on 13 June 2023.

Organisation, Training and Sub-contracting Requirements in Annex 2 of the Circular

- 5. With the launch of a new tier of BIM Coordinator, namely the CIC-Certified BIM Coordinators (Associate) ("CCBC(A)¹"), by the CIC, the subitem (b) BIM Coordinator is amended as follows with effect for all technical & fee proposals of consultancy agreements or construction works tenders to be invited on or after 1 January 2024
- (b) BIM Coordinator shall be a CIC-Certified BIM Coordinator (CCBC) or CIC-Certified BIM Coordinator (Associate) and with at least half of the BIM Coordinators attaining the qualification of CCBC in the BIM team.

For BIM practitioners who fulfilled the entry requirements of CCBC via the Normal or Adept Route, you may apply for CCBC(A) without the need to submit portfolio or competency statement and attend interview assessment. Register online at https://bim.cic.hk/en/certification_coordinator_associate/register now!

The application for CCBC(A) will be open for 2 years after launch in March 2023 and subject to review afterwards.

Tips for CIC-Certified BIM Coordinators (Associate) (CCBC(A)) and BIM Mentor



Tips for CCBC(A)

- The 2 years' supervision period starts on the registration approval day if the CCBC(A) submitted the mentor's details during application. Otherwise, it will commence only when the BIM Mentor's details are received and endorsed by CIC. Any subsequent changes of the BIM Mentor should be sent to CIC promptly by email to bimcas@cic.hk.
- A copy of each signed Training Logbook should be submitted to CIC promptly after each meeting with the BIM Mentor.

- Meet with the CCBC(A) at least once per half year or before a change of mentor.
- Review the CCBC(A)'s training and experience on BIM coordination by reference to the core competencies (CC) requirements of a CCBC. May cover individual CC in each period but required to fulfil all CCs upon the end of the supervision period.
- Comment, sign and date the Training Logbook and provide guidance and advices to the CCBC(A) on any improvement need.

Adept Route to CCBM and CCBC
