Mandatory Continuing Professional Development (MCPD) Hours for Online Learning of the CIC BIM Standards General (Version 2.1 - 2021)

To encourage CCBMs and CCBCs to learn and understand the new CIC BIM Standards General (Version 2.1 - 2021) (the BIM Standards), the Building Information Modelling Certification and Accreditation Board (BIMCAB) approved that CCBMs and CCBCs are mandated to attend an online video training with quiz on the BIM Standards. The MCPD has been arranged and launched by CIC from October 2021.

The CCBM and CCBC, who have been given access to the online video training, have to complete the training and pass the quiz within 3 weeks. 3 MCPD hours will be granted which are required for the upcoming renewal of registration of CCBM or CCBC status as part of the minimum 12 CPD hours.



Issue No. 2 (Jan 2022)

Adept Route for CCBM application (valid from 1 January 2022)

BIMCAB approves to launch an Adept Route with effect from 1 January 2022 to facilitate practitioners who do not have a degree or a CIC-recognised degree to apply for Certification of BIM Managers. A review of the Adept Route will be carried out by the end of 2024.

In order to become a CCBM through the Adept Route, practitioners should have the required practical experience in BIM and in the construction industry, with recognised BIM competence and have completed a CIC-Accredited BIM Manager Course.




Special Path for CCBC to become CCBM
